A content management system, often abbreviated as CMS, is software that helps users create, manage, and modify content on a website without the need for specialized technical knowledge.

In simpler language, a content management system is a tool that helps you build a website without needing to write all the code from scratch (or even know how to code at all).

On a more technical level, a content management system is made up of two core parts:

**A content management application (CMA)** – this is the part that allows you to actually add and manage content on your site.

**A content delivery application (CDA)** – this is the back-end, behind-the-scenes process that takes the content you input in the CMA, stores it properly, and makes it visible to your visitors.



Most content management systems are pretty flexible nowadays. While there are some that focus on a specific use – like Magento and eCommerce – most of the popular content management systems can be used to create essentially any type of website. For Example: Static websites, Blogs, Forums, Social Networks, Portfolios etc.

#### Fundamental Outcome:

Cloud computing is a big shift from the traditional way businesses think about IT resources. Here are seven common reasons organizations are turning to cloud computing services.

#### Cost

Cloud computing eliminates the capital expense of buying hardware and software and setting up and running on-site data centers—the racks of servers, the round-the-clock electricity for power and cooling, the IT experts for managing the infrastructure. It adds up fast.

#### Speed

Most cloud computing services are provided self service and on demand, so even vast amounts of computing resources can be provisioned in minutes, typically with just a few mouse clicks, giving businesses a lot of flexibility and taking the pressure off capacity planning.

Patterns allow you to reuse design ideas, concepts independent of concrete code.
