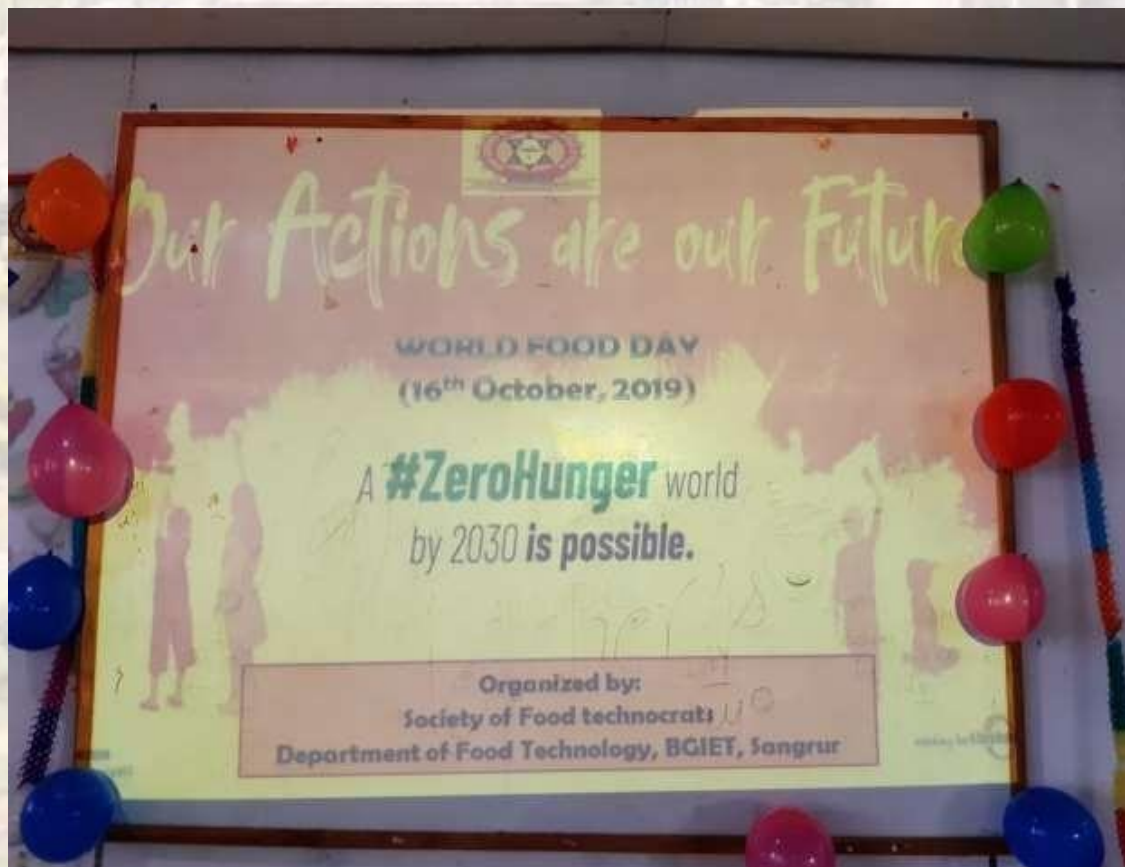
**Lecture on Food Safety and Personal Hygiene**
